

# Passion Week of Christ

## Palm Sunday

Jesus triumphant entrance to Jerusalem  
Multitude spreads garments and palm leaves on the ground as He rides on a donkey into the city

Matthew 21:1-11

## Monday

Jesus curses the fig tree that had no fruit  
Jesus weeps over Jerusalem  
Cleanses the Temple the second time

Mark 11:13-14, Luke 19:41, Matthew 21:12

## Tuesday

Jesus comes across the cursed fig tree - it has withered  
Prophesies destruction for his enemies  
Olivet discourse  
Judas makes a deal with Jewish leaders to betray Jesus

Mark 11:20, Matt 21:28-46, Mark 13, Mark 14:10-11

## Wednesday

The Gospels do not provide events for Wednesday

---

Isaiah 53:3-5, "He was despised and rejected by men, a man of sorrows, and familiar with suffering. Like one from whom men hide their faces he was despised and we esteemed him not. Surely he took up our infirmities and carried our sorrows, yet we considered him stricken by God, smitten by him and afflicted. But he was pierced for our transgressions, he was crushed for our iniquities; the punishment that brought us peace was upon him, and by HIS WOUNDS WE ARE HEALED." (NIV)

## Thursday

Peter and John find the room for the Passover and make other preparations  
Jesus washes the disciple's feet  
The Last Supper (The Lord's Supper)  
Jesus is betrayed by Judas  
Peter denies knowing Jesus 3 times

Mark 14:13-16, Matt 26:26

## Good Friday

Jewish leaders condemn Jesus  
Jesus brought before Pilate  
Jesus is beaten, scourged, mocked  
Judas hangs himself  
Jesus is crucified & dies  
Buried before sunset

Mark 14:64,  
Mark 15:1, 15, 25, 36, 37

## Saturday

Pilate puts guards on the tomb so that no one can steal the body of Jesus

Matt 27:62-66

## Resurrection Sunday

JESUS RISES FROM THE DEAD  
EMPTY TOMB  
ANGELS APPEAR AT TOMB  
JESUS APPEARS 5 TIMES TO DISCIPLES

Matt 28, Mark 16, Luke 24,  
John 20
