Palm Sunday

- Jesus triumphant entrance to Jerusalem
- Multitude spreads garments and palm leaves on the ground as He rides on a donkey into the city

Matthew 21:1-11

Monday

- Jesus curses the fig tree that had no fruit
- Jesus weeps over Jerusalem
- Cleanses the Temple the second time

Mark 11:13-14
Luke 19:41
Matthew 21:12

Tuesday

- Jesus comes across the cursed fig tree - it has withered
- Prophesies destruction for his enemies
- Olivet discourse
- Judas makes a deal with Jewish leaders to betray Jesus

Mark 11:20,
Matt. 21:28-46

Wednesday

- The Gospels do not provide events for Wednesday
- Take the time today to pray and thank our Lord for His sacrifice and the promise of Eternal Life with Him!

"Yet he himself bore our sicknesses, and he carried our pains; but we in turn regarded him stricken, struck down by God, and afflicted. Thursday

- Peter and John find the room for the Passover and make other preparations
- Jesus washes disciple's feet
- The Last Supper
- Jesus is betrayed by Judas
- Peter denies knowing Jesus 3 times

Matt. 26:47-48, 69-75

Good Friday

- Jewish leaders condemn Jesus
- Jesus brought before Pilate
- Jesus is beaten, scourged, mocked
- Judas hangs himself
- Jesus is crucified & dies
- Buried before sunset

Mark 15:1,15,25,36,37

Saturday

- Pilate puts guards on the tomb so that no one can steal the body of Jesus

Easter

- JESUS RISES FROM THE DEAD
- EMPTY TOMB
- ANGELS APPEAR AT TOMB
- OVER THE NEXT SEVERAL DAYS, JESUS APPEARS 5 TIMES TO HIS DISCIPLES
