# WOMEN AND THE WORD OF GOD: WOMEN AS TEACHERS

The Bible is clear that the Overseer (the Pastor) of a church is to be the husband of one wife - and thus the Pastor is to be a man. This follows God's design for marriage, in that the man bears the responsibility of the family. The male Pastor bears the responsibility of the church family. However, beyond the Pastor himself and his preaching, there are many environments where the word of God is taught in the church body. The Old Testament shows women professing God's works to mixed groups, and the New Testament is full of examples where women were witnesses of the resurrected Christ and were instrumental leaders and teachers in the early church. God desires to equip all believers, regardless of gender, to extend his kingdom, to serve and to lead others.
